

# MTESOL DISTANCE

The University of Auckland Department of Applied Language Studies and Linguistics offers a web-based, distance programme in TESOL – Master of Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (MTESOL).

The MTESOL can be completed in one year of full-time study or up to four years part-time. It consists of either eight taught courses or six taught courses and a short dissertation.

Entry requirements include:

- Either a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) or equivalent in a relevant subject or a Bachelor of Arts (with a major in a relevant subject) and a Dip TESOL;

- At least two years' relevant teaching experience (preferably in the teaching of English as a second/foreign language);
- IELTS (Academic) 6.5 or equivalent (for international students).
